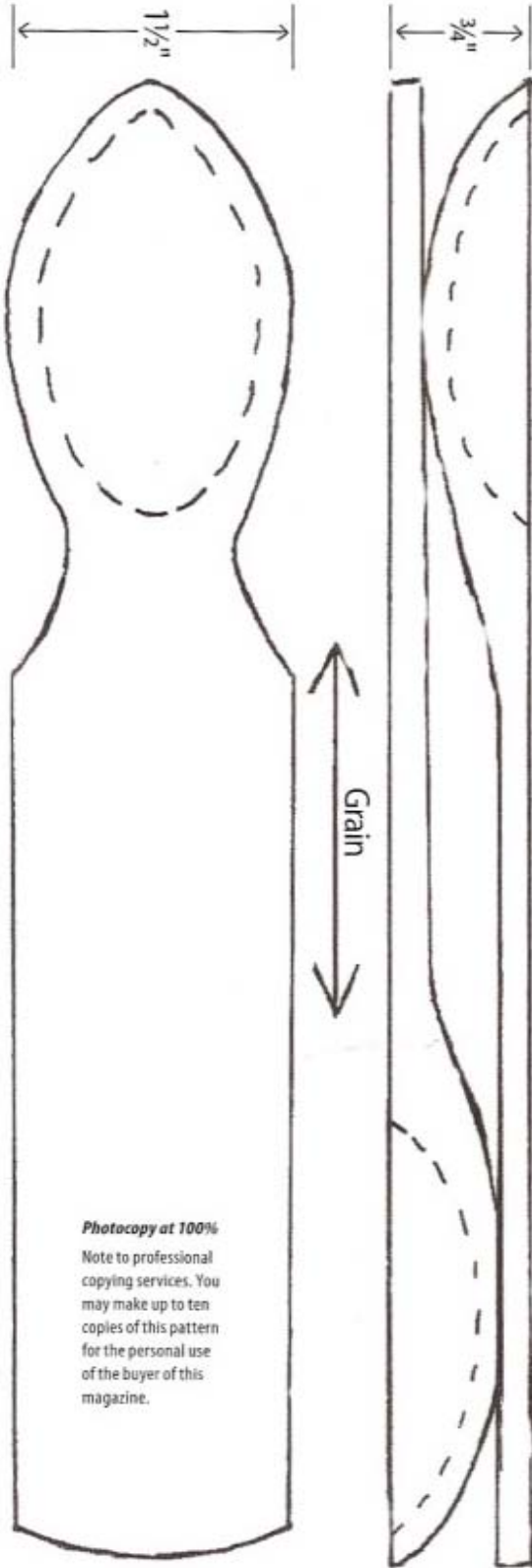

TOOLS:

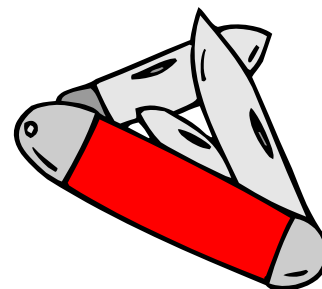
Whittling knife of choice



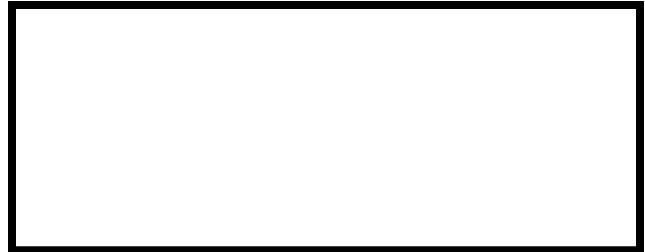
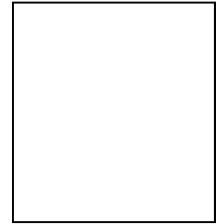
